



# PRIOR AUTHORIZATION (PA) INFORMATIONAL CHECKLIST

For your reference, please see the following checklist designed as a guide to list supporting clinical documentation that may be required by the insurance plan. The following information is relevant for patients diagnosed with the FDA approved indication for the applicable Mirum product.

Insurance plans may process prior authorization requests quickly if expedited review is requested by the health care provider.

## Criteria for Insurance Plans Without Policy

### Clinical Diagnosis

- Serum Bile Acid (sBA) Measurement
- Genetic Test Results
- Clinical Determination (3 of 7 clinical criteria are present)

### Trial of Other Treatments or Reason Why Not Appropriate

- Cholestyramine
- Ursodiol
- Naltrexone
- Antihistamines
- Rifampin

### Documentation of Pruritus

- Itch Score (itchRO or CCS)
- Chart Notes (Include sleep disturbance notes)

### Supporting Clinical Documentation

- All Chart Notes
- Clinical papers
- Labs (i.e. ALT, AST, bilirubin)

## Re-authorization Considerations\*

- Submit as expedited
- Documentation on improvement while on medication  
(e.g. updated chart note and labs that were required for initial prior authorization)

\*Timing for re-authorizations may vary by insurance plan
